JUSTIFICATION

Youth for Christ in its eagerness to contribute to develop young students Character, has coordinated with this institutes to bring the students outside of their regular areas of comfort to Rancho Vida in La Entrada, copan, in order to be trained and prepared for their upcoming challenges in life. In Honduras statistics show that every hour a young person dies for different reasons, (use of drugs, STD'S alcohol abuse, violence, they get involved in Gangs, crime etc.) we suffer from the lack of instruction and education in the very core of the family, there's less instruction in topics related to the decision making about sexual intercourse drugs and alcohol. In this seminar we use the "Sin Excusas" material (without Excuses) to prepare them to take good decisions. It covers all this matter in a very deep, professional and effective way, that makes them see were this type of behavior is headed. We teach them how to practice self control and the importance of self team.

OBJECTIVES

GENERAL:

- We aim to train the students of these selected institutes using the camping method, and through the without excuses seminar.

ESPECIFIC:

- Friendly Exchange and experience among students and school counselors.
- To teach them elemental facts about AIDS/ STD'S.
- Offer the students valuable tools about how to protect and secure their future family.
- Develop strategies on how to effectively reject a pre-matrimonial sexual relationship as well as drugs and alcohol.
- Show them how to settle and follow up, their dreams and goals (short mid and long term).
- Share effective strategies on how to build up healthy relationships with peers, and others without involving sexual relationships.
- Establish a connection with the campers, share interest and build a relationship in order to win their trust and be able to present the gospel, giving them advice based on what the bible says.
- Comprehend that education, family and the respect to God its key for their integral development.

METHODOLOGY

Every activity has been meticulously programmed and are directed by our staff of volunteers:

- Clear rules and regulations: code of conduct and use of our facilities.
- All lectures are facilitated by suited and experienced conference speaker; audio visual aid is used in every conference to improve the reception on the students.
- Testimonials: Volunteers share their personal experiences, validating the importance of the knowledge acquired in the decision making process as well as strengthening the character.
- During and in between the lectures we include outdoor activities, fun ice breakers and dynamic games, this in order to maintain a trust environment, interact with campers and staff. A special teamwork training that will challenge them to climb a hill, get to the cross and enjoy of a beautiful view as well as to experience a life changing opportunity, accepting Jesus as their savior.



STAFF TRAINING

Every year we have different trainings for our volunteer's staff. This year the YFC Central America Area Training took place in Guatemala, a total of 8 leaders participated at this training. It was a wonderful time of communion with Hispanic YFC family in which our leaders received significant tools to improve the ministry.
